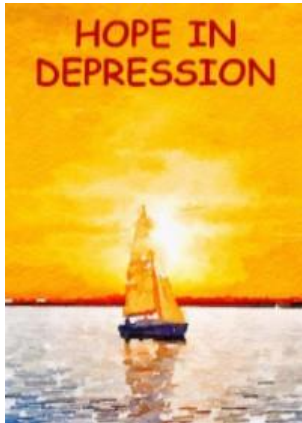
Whether under canvas, in a caravan or staying in a local hotel, there is a real sense of togetherness, as we seek God and hear his commission to transform this nation and beyond.
